FAQs Related to 2nd Major / Minors

When should I start taking courses?

Taking a 2nd Major or double minors:

Better start taking courses in 1st year

For Minor, can start at 2nd year

When do I have to register for the option?

If you opt for Major / Minor(s), you can declare it after completion of the first year study

Can I change from a Major to a Minor?

In principle, yes

Most of the Introductory courses for the Major and Minor are similar or the same.

You can make changes to the declaration of Minor or Major during the Course enrollment and ADD/DROP period
